Application Process - All materials due September 28.

All scholarship applicants must:

- » Submit the official HBC scholarship typed application form found on page 3.
- » Be a member of the NAHB Student Chapter at MSUM or NDSU.
- » Provide information on your academic standing, including:
 - 1. A copy of your student transcript through the summer 2018 semester. If you have just begun your first semester of a university program, you may substitute a copy of your high school transcript or technical program transcript, if applicable. **Unofficial copies of transcripts are acceptable**.
 - 2. A list of honors or awards received during your post-secondary education.
- » Provide a resume. This does not take the place of the two-page typewritten statement.
- » Include a two-page typewritten statement containing:
 - 1. Answers to the following questions:
 - Are you currently employed? If so, do you work in the construction industry?
 - Where do you want to work after graduation and why?
 - Where do you see yourself in five years? Ten years?
 - What sector of the construction industry are you most interested in and why?
 - 2. Information regarding work experiences related to the residential and commercial construction industry.
 - 3. Involvement in the NAHB Student Chapter. Please indicate how long you've been involved and describe your contributions to your Student Chapter. If you have just recently joined, please share what you would like to get out of belonging to the Student Chapter.
 - 4. Description of volunteer efforts and contributions to the community through school, church or any other organization during your college career.
 - Describe any volunteer experiences you have had with the HBA of F-M.
 - Describe what you have learned from volunteering.
 - 5. List financial aid, grants, scholarships, etc. you have received.
 - Please note if you have received a scholarship from HBC in the past.
 - 6. Explain why you are a deserving canidiate of this scholarship.

Judging

A scholarship evaluation committee consisting of HBC board trustees, HBA board directors, HBA members and staff, and Student Chapter advisors will determine recipients of scholarship awards based on information in the application packet. Applicants will be evaluated using a point system based on the items shown at right. Applications that do not contain all requested information will not be considered.

Applications will be judged on a point-based system:

Career objectives	20 points	
Resume	10 points	
Community involvement/activities	10 points	
Overall application	10 points	
Total Points	100 points

	Two-page typewritten statement with information requested on page 2.

Tips for a competitive application:

- * Use spell check.
- Use correct grammar.
- * Have someone proofread your application.
- * Work with Career Services at your school to develop your resume. Your resume does not replace any other part of the application; do not depend on it to explain your experiences.
