HBA offers continuing education for Minn. building contractors

FARGO, N.D. - The Home Builders Association of Fargo-Moorhead is offering classes to fulfill Minnesota contractor continuing education requirements Jan. 19 and Feb. 16 at the Skills & Technology Training Center at 1305 19th Ave. N. Fargo. The deadline for Minnesota contractors to submit documents to the Department of Labor and Industry for renewal is March 1, 2011. Licenses expire March 31, 2011, for those at the end of their two-year cycle.

- On Jan. 19, topics include geothermal heating and cooling, Minnesota building code hot topics, basics on building braced walls and the Minnesota home warranty law.
- The Feb. 16 class is “Building Technology: Systems and Interior Finishes.”

Both classes include the energy credit required for contractors each renewal cycle and are sponsored by the City of Moorhead. January classes are approved by the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry for seven hours of continuing education for the residential building industry. The Feb. 16 class is pending approval for seven hours of continuing education.
