Application Process

All scholarship applicants must:

Type and submit the official Scholarship Application Form before deadline (page 3).

- » Use spell check.
- » Use correct grammar.
- » Have someone proofread your application.
- » Deadline: 4:30 p.m. March 27, 2020

Include a copy of your most recent student transcript.

» Unofficial copies are acceptable through most recent completed semester

Include up to a two-page typewritten statement of the following:

- » Education objectives (both short and long-term);
- » Career goals beyond post-secondary education;
- » Job shadowing experience (if applicable);
- » Information concerning the applicant's construction work experiences and/or courses related to the construction industry;
- » Description of course(s), experience or individual(s) that have influenced applicant's interest in the construction trades, and why or how the applicant has been influenced; and
- » Any honors or awards received while in high school.

Provide two letters of recommendation (mailed separately).

- The letters should be mailed to Home Builders Care of Fargo-Moorhead Foundation, 1802 32nd Ave. S., Fargo, ND 58103 or emailed to summer@hbcfm.com.
- » Applicants are encouraged to include at least one letter from a source outside of their high school.

Plan to enroll in residential construction trades or a related field (i.e., plumbing, electrical, building construction technology, construction management, heating/air conditioning, etc.) at:

- » Minnesota State Community and Technical College (M State) in Moorhead.
- » North Dakota State College of Science (NDSCS) in Wahpeton or
- » Provide proof of enrollment within 18 months of graduation.

Include a brief typewritten description of financial situation. Include receipts of financial aid, grants, scholarships, etc.

Scholarships will be presented at the Parade Picnic. Event details will be provided to all scholarship recipients.

- » Applications that do not contain all requested information will not be considered for scholarship awards.

Judging Guidelines

A scholarship evaluation committee consisting of Home Builders Care of Fargo-Moorhead Foundation Board Trustees, HBA of F-M members and staff, and Student Chapter advisors will determine recipients of scholarship awards based on information in the application packet.

Applicants will be evaluated using a point system based on the items listed below. Incomplete applications will not be considered for scholarship awards.

Awards

Scholarship amounts can vary and one or more awards may be issued. The awarded funds will be held until the student has graduated from high school and proof of enrollment at Minnesota State Community and Technical College or North Dakota State College of Science is provided to Home Builders Care of Fargo-Moorhead Foundation. Proof of enrollment must be provided within 18 months of graduation or the scholarship will be forfeited.
